


The project utilised frameless glass doors and flush twin glazed doors, complemented by the use of brushed aluminium ironmongery. The finished project provided a modern design to the office space. Designed to offer specifiers the opportunity to create partitioning without vertical mullions to a maximum height of 4000mm, the system is available in Single, 58mm Twin Glazed and 105mm Twin Glazed options and offers seamless integration into drywall.
